KidStuf is a dynamic program once a month on Sunday nights where kids bring their parents. Together they learn about life and the difference Jesus makes when we follow Him.

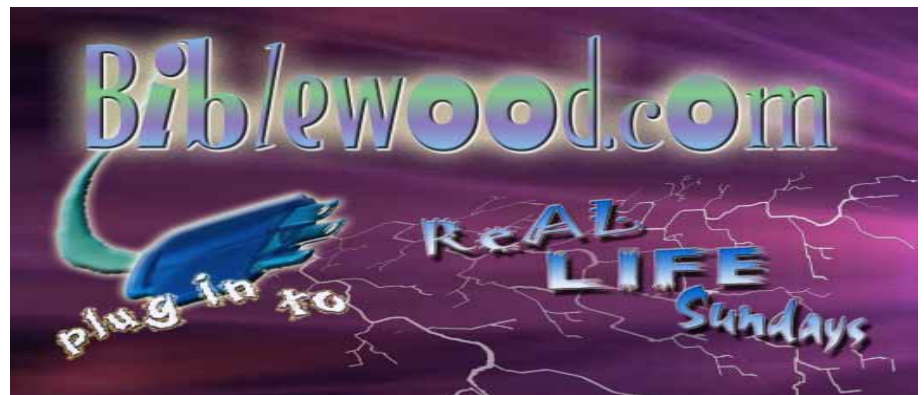

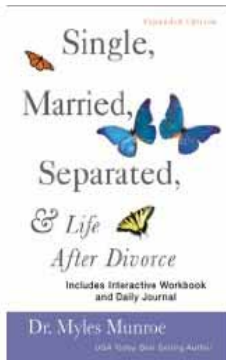
Sunday, February 28, 12:30 - 2:00 PM

In the 21st Century, the lines of theological distinction are becoming more and more blurred. One of the chief areas where this is true is in the matter of "justification" – or what it takes and means to be "saved from sin." The Apostle Paul wrote in a time when the truth of the gospel was at stake. Jewish teachers that claimed to be Christians tried to blend Jewish Law with Christian faith. This comes to us in the formula "Jesus + works = ?". Is it Jesus alone, faith alone, grace alone? Come and hear about the wonderful details of salvation in Christ. The class is set up in an interactive setting, where the teachers will stop and answer questions. We laugh, we cry (sometimes) as we share together in this type of study.
