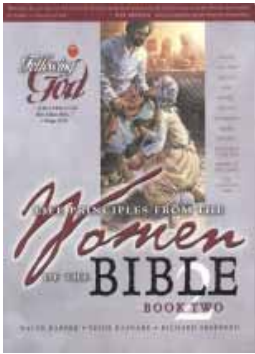
## Thanks Tanya!

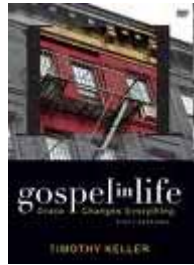
## Women's Summer Bible Study

July 17 - Church stage enhancements or a local home

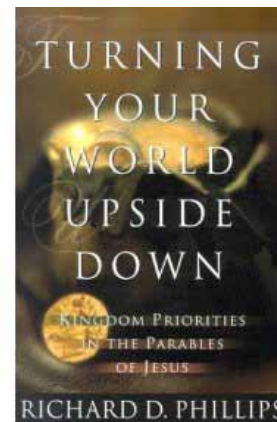

## Global Connections Class June 6- August 22

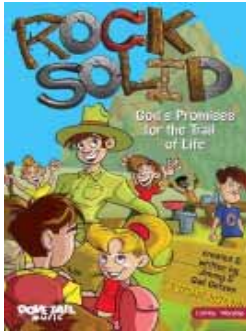

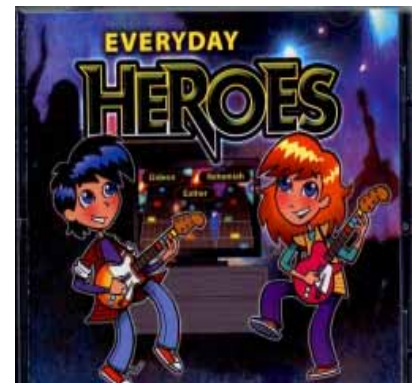

# Local Outreach

## Updates from Local Outreach . . .

**Tim & Nicole Carey** (Campus Crusade - MidSouth Region) Did you know that in New York City there are over one million college students with over 100 countries represented? The world is at our doorstep. It has been fun to use our Spring Breaks over the past two years to serve in the city - trusting Christ to confront issues that we can't see back home. Our two staff and seven students joined about 100 others from UNC-Greensboro, UNC-Chapel Hill, and Charleston, SC. We unleashed the students to interact and engage with folks from all different backgrounds - whether religion, sexual orientation, culture, race - and were swept away by God's heart for the people of New York City. Through the week we saw 13 students invite Christ into their lives and the Gospel was clearly shared over 200 times.

**Pete & Carra Selent** (Campus Crusade - Triad) Over Spring break, Pete hopped on a bus with 50 of our triad students from High Point University, UNC Greensboro and Wake Forest to join other students to reach the 1,000,000 students in New York City. The conversations were overwhelming at times, but they really taught the students to depend on the Holy Spirit for guidance and for the results. The NY trip was an awesome time of watching and challenging our students to engage with others who don't have the same "Bible Belt" background. At least 13 students accepted Christ as their Savior that week and many hundreds more heard clear presentations of the Gospel - some for the very first time! It's hard to say which was more exciting to see...The NYC students coming to Christ, or the transformation that took place in so many of our Triad students as they caught on to the fact that the Lord can use them so mightily to transform the nations.

**Summer Russell** (Child Evangelism) - Child Evangelism is gearing up for the second Triad Spectacular to be held in Greensboro on November 13. Last year over 5,000 attended and 85 decisions for Christ were made. They need help in many areas.
